HOST LEAGUE, ASSOCIATION, TEAM OFFERS 0 NIGHTS FOOD AND LODGING TO PLAYERS AND CHEERLEADERS. ANY NON-BOWL ACTIVITIES SHALL BE DISCUSSED AND AGREED TO BEFOREHAND. **IF THE HOST LEAGUE, ASSOCIATION OR TEAM FAILS TO COMPLY WITH 0 NIGHTS FOOD AND LODGING, THE HOST LEAGUE, ASSOCIATION, OR TEAM SHALL BE SUBJECT TO ALL EXPENSES INCURRED BY THE VISITING TEAM, NOT TO EXCEED \$2,500.00.**

IF THE HOST LEAGUE, ASSOCIATION OR TEAM AGREES TO PROVIDE ANY ACCOMODATIONS (FOOD AND/OR LODGING), THEY SHALL PROVIDE FOR ALL THE PLAYERS AND ALL THE CHEERLEADERS OF THE VISITING TEAM. THE HOST LEAGUE, ASSOCIATION, OR TEAM MUST APPROVE ACCOMODATIONS FOR MASCOTS OR STUDENT MANAGERS.

TEAMS PARTICIPATING IN POST-SEASON BOWL GAMES SHALL MEET THE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH POP WARNER OFFICIAL RULES, RULE 29, S2 (2005).

THE APPLICABLE STATE STANDARD (NCAA OR NATIONAL FEDERATION) AND THE POP WARNER NATIONAL RULEBOOK WILL BE THE ONLY RULES IN EFFECT AT ALL BOWL GAMES. See Pop Warner Official Rules, Rule 29, S5 (2005).

BOTH TEAMS MUST PRODUCE A CERTIFIED ROSTER AND PHOTO IDENTIFICATION IN ORDER TO WEIGH-IN. WEIGH-INS SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH POP WARNER OFFICIAL RULES, RULE 3, S1 OR S2 (2005). IF S2 IS USED, WEIGH-INS SHALL BE WITH REQUIRED SAFETY EQUIPMENT ONLY, EXCEPT HELMETS. EXTRA PADS MAY BE REMOVED BEFORE WEIGH-INS (ARM PADS, NECK ROLLS, ETC.).

NO TEAM OR SQUAD MAY BE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN BOWL GAMES IF IT HAS NOT MET THE NATIONALLY PUBLISHED SCHOLASTIC REQUIREMENTS. See Pop Warner Official Rules, Article 6, S4 (2005).

IF ANY LEAGUE IN THIS AGREEMENT IS UNABLE TO PROVIDE A TEAM OF THE SAME AGE/WEIGHT DIVISION AT THE LOCATION AND ON THE AGREED DATE AND TIME ON THE SIGNED CONTRACT, IT SHALL PAY TO THE OPPOSING LEAGUE THE FOLLOWING FINE:
